INTRODUCTION

Land Management Training Center, under the Ministry of Land Management, Cooperatives and Poverty Alleviation, Government of Nepal, is organising “**International Workshop on Land Use Planning**” from **February 16-17, 2023** at its campus in Dhulikhel, Kavrepalanchowk.
